Another blessing was getting to celebrate our 8th Anniversary in Santo Domingo, Xenacoj. We are so thankful for all that the Lord has done and continues to do in this town. We had our sister church in Santiago join us, and had 4 people accept Christ as their Savior and 6 souls rededicated their lives to The Lord!. Praise the Lord!

Some current prayer requests we have is finances toward the building project. We are in the process of making blocks to start the build of our security wall. Then we will begin the build of phase 1 as the finances come in to do so. Praise The Lord we have currently raised 10% of our total goal! We also ask for your prayers toward this ministry of getting back in the public schools, and for many children to accept Christ as their Savior. We've also been asked to come once a month to a village 3 hours away to share the gospel with 100 children! Our landlord and his family have started the work but called me as they are not preachers and have asked me to share the gospel once a month. They are doing a great work, and already have 3 families they are reaching in a Sunday school type fashion. We are so thankful for the Lord continuing to open doors for our family here in Guatemala.
