On day 5 she seemed to be getting worse, so we took her to a clinic in Antigua. After tests and an X-Ray, they determined it was RSV and advised us to admit her to our hospital in the city. Maurisa

and Addie were transported by ambulance to the city as Addie was immediately put on oxygen. After 3 nights in the hospital, she was doing much better and discharged. She will be on medication and breathing treatments for the next 10 days, but we praise the Lord for His touch and healing hand over our baby girl and for every prayer prayed for her.
